NOTICE OF A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING of the Franchise and Concession Review Committee and the New York City Department of Parks & Recreation ("NYC Parks") to be held on Monday, January 13, 2025, at 22 Reade Street, Spector Hall, Manhattan, New York, NY 10007 commencing at 2:30 p.m. relative to:

INTENT TO AWARD as a concession a License Agreement ("License") to SSC&R LLC for the renovation, operation, and maintenance of a food service facility and special event concession at the South Shore Golf Course, Staten Island. R104-R-2024.

The License will commence upon Notice to Proceed and end no later than January 15, 2044.

Compensation to the City will be as follows: The greater of the annual minimum fee versus the annual percentage of gross receipts:

Payments to the City for each Operating Licensee shall pay the City License fees for each Operating Year consisting of the higher of the minimum annual fee or an annual percentage of Gross Receipts derived from the operation of the Licensed Premises as set forth below:
